## Instructions for use

- Prepare the base with a specific Primer, Isolante Acrilico or levelling base like Isolante Ancorante Primer Berico
- Application with stainless steel or plastic trowel
- Application of 1 or more coatings
- Base must be clean and dry, any unsubstantial parts, traces of oil or grease must be removed; plaster any irregularity of the base
- Spread with a plastic trowel a thick coat of MEDITERRANEO, crossing paths as to leave evident traces of the trowel. When dry, finish with coloured waxes or veiling
- Temperature of application 5° to 35°C
